CIBA/Younger Chemists Committee Travel Award

Awards \$1,000 for young and early-career chemists to travel to and participate in ACS national or regional meetings. Intended for scientists under 35 who have postdoctoral appointments or are within the first 7 years of their professional career. Awarded twice each year.

Women Chemists Committee Eli Lilly Travel Award

Provides travel funding based on scientific merit and financial need for undergraduate, graduate, and postdoctoral female chemists to present the results of their research. The award also provides networking opportunities with distinguished and renown professionals in the chemical enterprise.

Women Chemists Committee Overcoming Challenges Award

Recognizes a female undergraduate for overcoming hardship to achieve success in chemistry. Award of \$250 and up to \$1000 for travel expenses to the ACS Fall Meeting. Applicant must be an undergraduate currently enrolled in a two-year chemistry-related program or pursuing a major or minor in a four-year chemistry program at a school that does not grant doctorates in chemistry.

WCC Merck Research Award

Recognizes eight 3rd and 4th year graduate students who will present their research at an awards symposium held during the Fall ACS Meeting. Awardees will receive a \$1,500 stipend to cover meeting expenses.

Committee On Chemists With Disabilities Travel Award

Offers up to \$3000 which includes travel and lodging to encourage undergraduate/graduate students and post-docs with disabilities who will present an oral or poster presentation at the ACS Fall or Spring Meeting.

The Stanley C. Israel Award For Advancing Diversity In The Chemical Sciences

This is an ACS Regional award to recognize individuals and/or institutions that have advanced diversity in the chemical sciences and significantly stimulated or fostered activities that promote inclusiveness within-the region. The award consists of a medal and a \$1,000 grant to support activities that further the award's purpose, plus travel expenses to the award presentation.

Young Chemists Committee Starter Grant

Grants up to \$200 to help localsection YCCs sponsor their first big event or launch a new program and, to network with other scientists in their area. Applications are reviewed year round.

Priscilla Carney Jones Scholarship

Provides scholarships for female undergraduate majors in chemistry or related discipline, beginning their junior or senior year of study, and is based on need and scholarship. Minimum \$1,500 award may be used to defray tuition, books, and lab fees.
